Motion

That this Council resolves to:

1. Note that the Strand, Dee Why Beach, has become one of the northern beaches' most popular attractions for both residents and people out of the Warringah Council area and is used extensively for dining and recreation.
2. That Council conduct public consultation with residents of the Strand, shop owners and other stake holder on closing off some or all of the Strand to facilitate a larger area of open space for dining and recreation and also call for public comment on ideas to make further improvements to the Strand and adjacent areas.
3. Request the General Manager to ensure a report is completed and presented to Council within three months advising on:
 - a) Results of public consultation and ideas proposed by the community for the betterment of the Strand, Dee Why Beach and adjoining areas;
 - b) The feasibility of closing all or some of the Strand off so as to facilitate a greater area for dining and recreation;
 - c) Estimated costs and time such works will take to complete;
 - d) Availability of funding, particularly investigation of whether further funds can be obtained via amendment to Warringah's section 94 plan and whether section 93 Voluntary Planning agreements can be entered into with any development applicants to assist with funding the project.
