

That Council resolves:

- 1) To note that the New South Wales Environmental Defenders Office has been commissioned by local community groups, at no cost to Council, to review the processing the Local Environment Plan for the Dee Why Town Centre and provide legal advice as to the chances of success for judicial review of the Minister's decision approving the height increase;
- 2) In order to facilitate the review, that Council requests the General Manager to provide all documents including but not limited to the Dee Why Town Centre LEP, Development Applications and assessment reports, correspondence between Council, the former Administrator and the Minister for Planning or the Department, Diary Notes or Files notes concerning any matter pertaining to the LEP, and provide access to Council staff that were involved in the matter to facilitate a proper review of the process in the interests of our community.
- 3) That upon the completion of the NSW Environmental Defenders' Office's Report, it immediately be considered by Council for appropriate action.
