Motion – Childcare Services in Warringah

That this Council resolves to:

Remove from the Draft Strategic Community Plan the proposal regarding the outsourcing of childcare in Warringah until a comprehensive report analysing the following is presented to full Council for consideration and determination:

- a) The benefits and disadvantages of the proposal financially;
- b) The benefits and disadvantages of the proposal regarding the level of care provided to children at the Centres;
- c) The benefits and disadvantages of the proposal regarding the levels of services and infrastructure;
- d) Studies of other Councils who have pursued such arrangements and the level of success and any problems that have arisen; and
- e) Full consultation with parents and staff of Council's Child Care Centres as to the proposal;
- f) Exploration of options to continue provision of Council operated childcare services at market based rates.
