

Council Meeting 12 May 2009

Motion - Proposed Lease Manly Small Bore Rifle Club - Passmore Reserve, Manly Vale

A. That Council agree to a 5 year lease to Manly Small Bore Rifle Club Incorporated for the land defined as Lot 1, DP 789165 and Part Portion 2743 DP 752038, Campbell Parade, Manly Vale for the purpose of a Small Bore Rifle Club. The terms of the lease will be generally consistent with the advertised Heads of Agreement.

B. The lease shall include three additional requirements:

- 1) that, if considered appropriate by the relevant licensing body (currently the NSW Police Firearms Registry), an annual inspection and report on the safety of the facility and its operation be undertaken at the Club's expense. Any works recommended by the licensing body shall be undertaken as soon as possible by the Club;
- 2) that the responsibility for, all buildings and structures on the site remain with the Club;
- 3) that the Club instigate reasonable measures to prevent any additional contamination of the land as a result of its activities; and
- 4) that the Club be responsible for the active management of weeds within their lease area and undertake bush regeneration of the lease area.

C. That the General Manager be granted delegation to finalise the leasing arrangements and to execute any documentation required on behalf of Council in relation to this matter consistent with this report.

That this Council resolves to:

1. Note:

a) That numerous Corporate organisations have abolished staff bonuses and introduced wage freezes; and

b) That the Federal and State Government Public Services do not have provision for Staff bonuses and that the State Public Service is to cut its Senior Executive Service by 20%, frozen recruitment of Senior Officers and non-front line employees;

2. a) Discontinue all staff and contractor bonus payments.

b) That the General Manager furnish a report to Council within one month identifying ways in which cost savings can be made by the abolition of certain Executive and management positions and implementing a leaner and more efficient management structure.
