10.1 NOTICE OF MOTION NO 10/2014 - CUBBY HOUSE TOY LIBRARY

1. That Council notes:

A The Cubby House Toy Library, Dee Why is a community-based organisation that has served the needs and interests of children with additional needs since 1980.

B. These additional needs may be physical, developmental, learning, speech, emotional or social.

C. It is the only toy library for children with additional needs on Sydney's northern beaches.

D. An Occupational Therapist (OT) has attended the Cubby House Toy Library on Thursday, Friday and Saturday mornings to assist parents in selecting suitable toys and provide ideas for play.

E. Sadly, due to increasing costs, the Cubby House Toy Library has decided to close and cancel its not-for-profit Incorporation status and desires to donate its collection to another Non-Government Organisation provider and seeks Warringah Council's assistance to facilitate transition and;

2. That Council:

A. Acknowledges and commends the Cubby House Toy Library, its administrators and volunteers who have dedicated over three decades to serving the needs and interests of children with additional needs and supported families with children of additional needs

B. Acknowledges that Council staff have met with Early Education to facilitate the handover of the Cubby House Toy Library's collection and is also in discussions with Early Education about taking on the premises at Howard Avenue, Dee Why until December 2015.
