### Rescission Motion

We hereby give notice of the following motion of rescission:

1. That the Council's resolution relating to Item 9.7 Adoption of Strategic Community Plan – "The Budget 2010" Items I(c) and J(5) BP REF 72 passed at the meeting of the Council held on 22 June 2010 (reprinted in italics below).

#### I. FEES & CHARGES

*That the following minor amendments only be approved to the exhibited Draft Schedule of Fees & Charges 2010/11:*

- c) *Parking Sticker Beaches & Reserves for residents, ratepayers, Pittwater residents and non residents – fees for ¼ year, ½ year and ¾ year be deleted*

#### J. AMENDMENTS TO DRAFT STRATEGIC COMMUNITY PLAN 2010 FOLLOWING COMMUNITY CONSULTATION

5. *That beach reserve parking stickers be provided in accordance with the following requirements*
  - *The stickers are non transferable and registered to a vehicle*
  - *The sticker is provided on request*
  - *A limit of one free parking sticker be provided per rateable property*
2. That the Council's resolution relating to Item 3.14 Notice of Motion No 41/2010 Parking Sticker Administration Options and Summer Parking Congestion Surveys BP REF 14 passed at the meeting of the Council held on 3 August 2010 (reprinted in italics below).

*That Council:*

1. *Requests a review of the administration of the sale to residents of their second beach reserve parking stickers that provides a monthly progress report to councillors for the first 12 months of the new system on the rate of resident participation in the scheme,*

*feedback including complaints and compliments, the income received from sticker sales and the costs associated with collecting the new fee; and*

2. *Conducts a survey of parking conditions during the summers of 2010-11 and 2011-12, to monitor changed circumstances and issues arising from the new resident parking restrictions and report this to the traffic committee prior to reporting this back to Council.*
3. *That a public meeting be held to review the quarterly expenditure and income and the data arising from the resident parking.*

be and is hereby rescinded.

### **CONSEQUENTIAL MOTION**

Should the rescission motion be ADOPTED we give notice that it is our intention to move the following motion in relation to Item I and J (5) in lieu thereof of which due notice is hereby given:

- J. 5. That the two current beach reserve parking stickers per household showing the expiry date of 31 August, 2010 have their expiry period extended to provide free beach reserve parking until the date of 31 August 2011 and that replacement and additional stickers be supplied to residents as per previous arrangements.
6. That a further parking study be undertaken across the local government area to look at other location parking meters can be installed to provide equitable access to parking.
