Frequent Flyer Points**

Question

Does Council require officers to hand over to Warringah Council frequent flyer points gained on personal credit cards for expenditure incurred on Council work related expenses which are subsequently claimed back and reimbursed by Council?

Response

No. It is inevitable that on occasion staff will need to use a personal credit card for a business purchase and in doing so they incur personal risk and potential interest charges.

It would be neither practicable nor worthwhile from a financial point of view to attempt to recover any bonus points earned by the staff member, for what is a rare occurrence.
